## **Community Health Worker Certificate of Completion Program Details**

The Integrated Public Health Community Health Worker Certificate of Completion (CCL) program (16-18 credits) is designed for individuals new to the healthcare field and those already in the healthcare field who wish to grow their capacity to support community-oriented health systems. New cohorts start in March of the Spring of 2024 and again in October of 2024. The Spring and Fall cohorts begin by taking IPH 101: Introduction to Public Health. The Integrated Public Health (IPH) classes are to be taken sequentially. The co-requisite courses can be taken anytime throughout the program and must be completed before the final practicum IPH 275. Please follow this course progression:

- 1. IPH101: Introduction to Public Health
- 2. IPH105: Introduction to Community Health Work
- 3. IPH 112: Community-Based Health Education in Health and Illness 4. IPH205: Chronic Disease Management

Co-Requisites: Take any two before taking IPH275

5. HCC146: Intermediate Medical Terminology for Healthcare Professionals or HCC 145AA: Common Medical Terminology for Health Care Professionals or SPA117: Health Care Spanish I

## and

- 6. HES 100: Healthful Living or HES 210: Cultural Aspects of Health and Illness
- 7. After the first four IPH courses and two co-requisite courses are completed, the final course is: IPH275: Community Health Work Practicum
